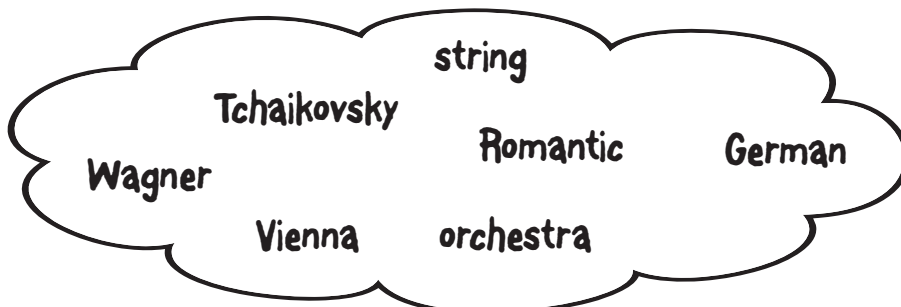


First, listen to the performance of Johannes Brahms' *Hungarian Dance No.5*, then answer these questions.
