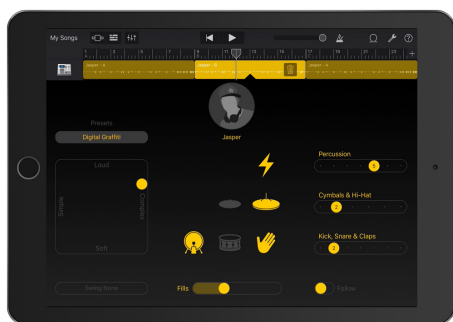
Task A:

Research on the internet and write 1-2 sentences about the musical style of dubstep. Where did it originate? What styles of music are similar? What are the prominent instruments in it?

Task B:

Create a dubstep drum part in A-B-A form using the drummer **Jasper**.

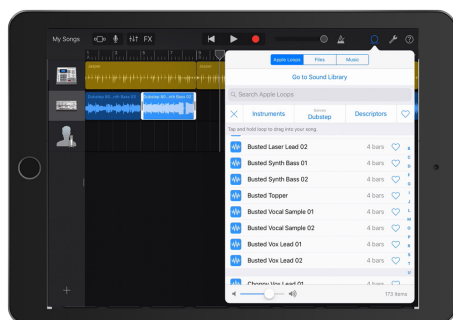


- Choose **Drummer** and then select the drummer **Jasper**.
- Use the plus sign to the right of the bar indicator to add a B section.
- Experiment with varying settings to create contrast between the A and B sections.
- Duplicate the A section to make sure that the piece is in A-B-A form.

Task C:

Add a bass line and other instruments and effects using prepared loops to complete a dubstep inspired piece.



- From the track view, click the icon that looks like a loop of string to open the loops library.
- With the loops library open, click on **Genres** and choose **Dubstep** to filter the loops available to include only those suitable for this style.
- Copy and paste anything you use in the A section to the repeat of the A section, to keep the piece in ABA form.
