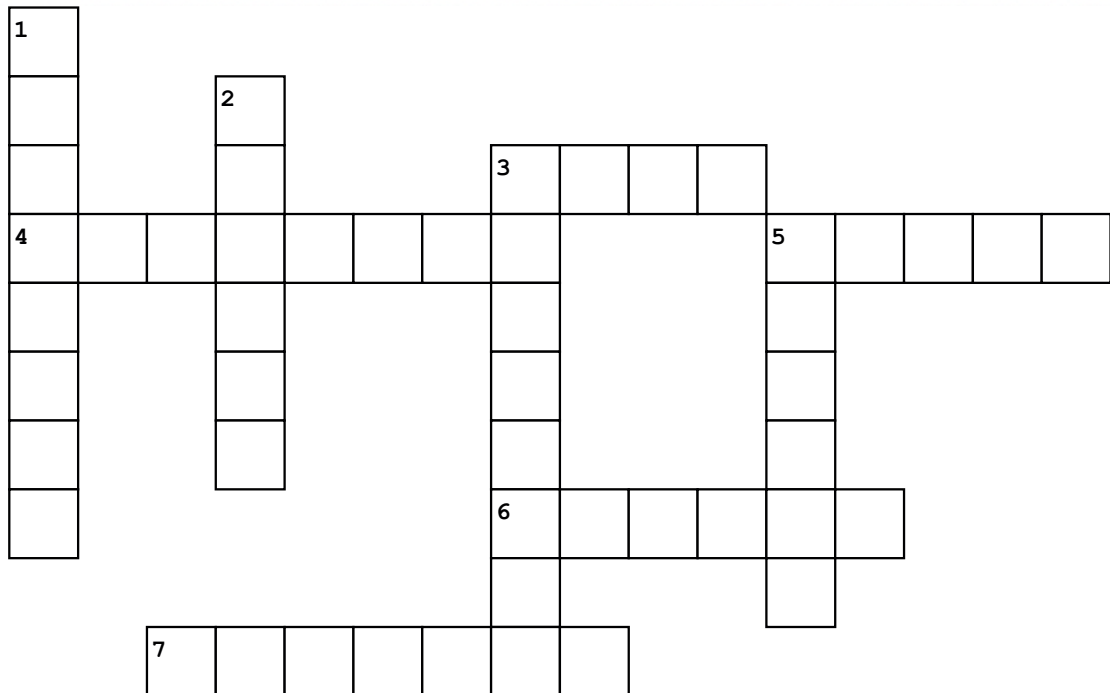




Across

3. The largest and lowest-sounding brass instrument in the orchestra.
4. A woodwind instrument often used to first learn to play music, blown through the top.
5. A large string instrument played sitting down, held between the knees.
6. A string instrument with a body and neck, played by plucking or strumming.
7. A brass instrument with three valves, played by buzzing your lips into a mouthpiece.

Down

1. A woodwind instrument with a single reed, played by blowing into a mouthpiece.
2. A string instrument played with a bow, held under the chin.
3. A percussion instrument shaped like its name, played by hitting it with a small metal stick.
5. A percussion instrument made of a metal disc, played by hitting or crashing it against another.
