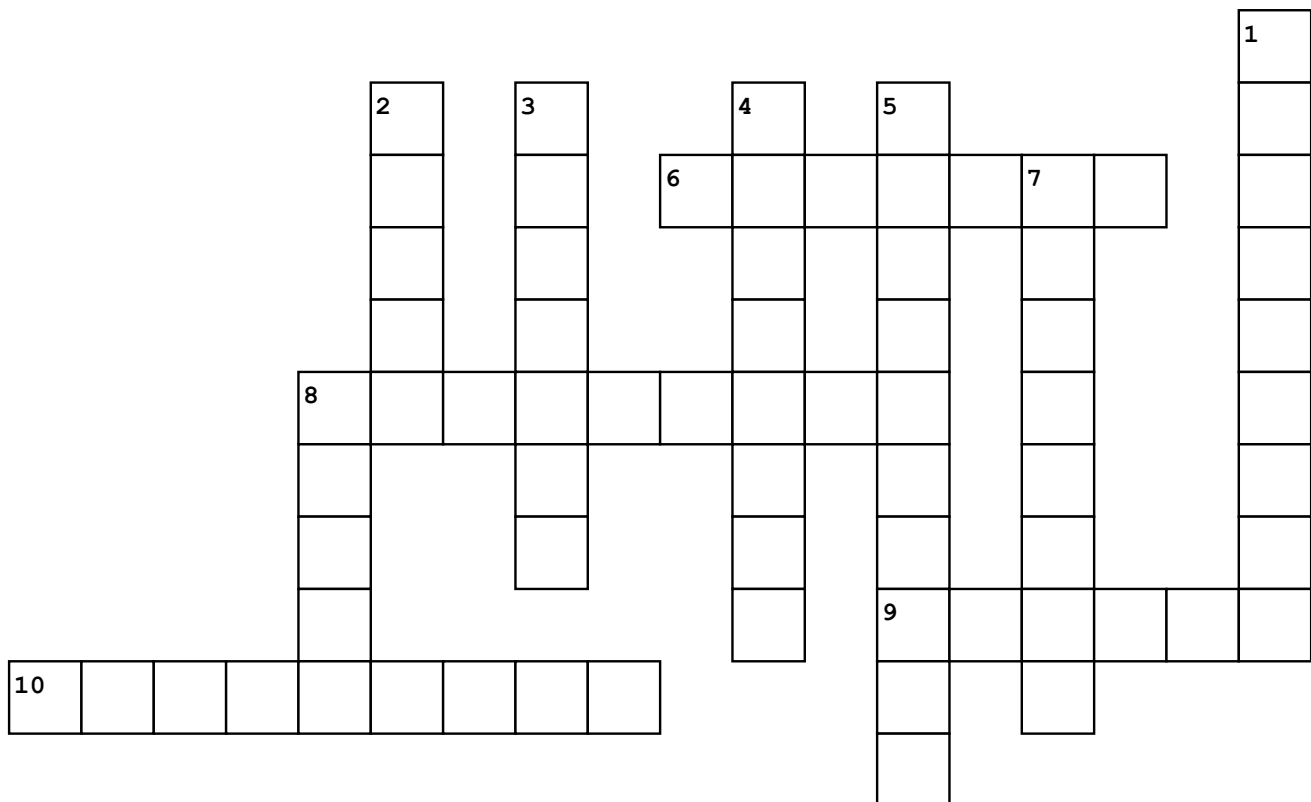


Musical Instruments

6. A percussion instrument similar to a xylophone, with a warmer, deeper sound.
8. A woodwind instrument with a single reed and a curved brass body.
9. A rope-tuned drum from West Africa, played with bare hands.
10. An instrument played by squeezing bellows while pressing buttons or keys.

1. A percussion instrument with wooden bars that are struck with mallets.
2. A string instrument similar to a violin, but larger and lower in pitch.
3. A large woodwind instrument known for its deep, rich tone.
4. A small string instrument with a rounded back, played with a pick.
5. A wind instrument from Aboriginal Australia, made from a naturally hollowed tree branch or trunk.
7. A wind instrument from Scotland with an air-filled bag and several pipes.
8. A stringed instrument from India, known for its buzzing, resonant sound.
