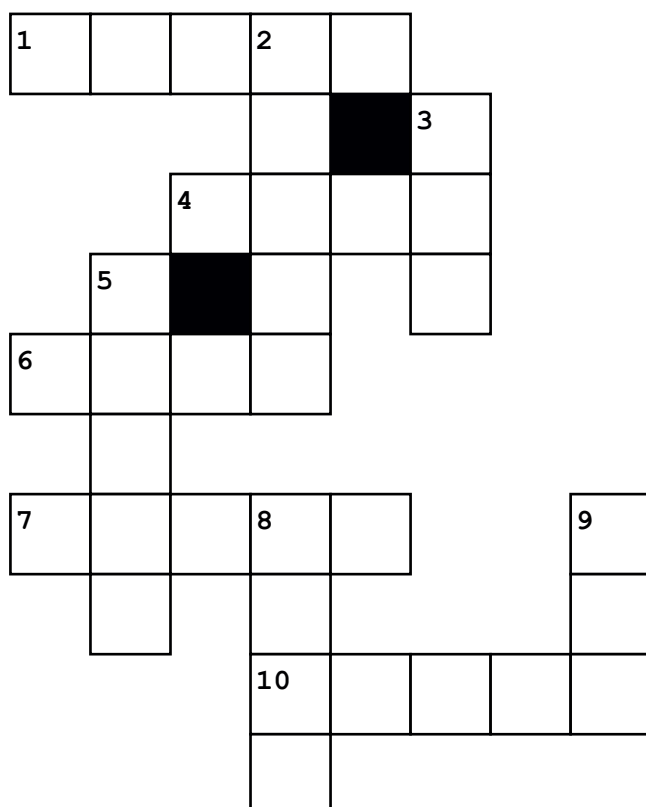




Across
